

**THE IMPLEMENTATION PROTOCOL  
REGARDING THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE  
BETWEEN  
GEORGIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY**

Georgia and The Republic of Turkey represented by the General Staff of the Republic of Turkey represented by the Ministry of Defense of Georgia (hereinafter referred to as parties) have agreed on the following articles for the use of the financial assistance that shall be allocated within the scope of Military Grant Agreement.

**ARTICLE I  
PURPOSE**

The purpose of this protocol is to establish the implementation essentials of the financial assistance of 228.000 (two hundred twenty eight thousand) YTL equivalent to U.S. dollars provided by the Republic of Turkey to the Ministry of Defense of Georgia.

**ARTICLE II  
SCOPE**

The financial assistance which shall be provided by Turkey will be used to meet the source requirements of the following activities:

1. The Partnership for Peace (PfP) and Center of Excellence-Defense Against Terrorism (CoE-DAT) courses expenditures of the military personnel of the Ministry of Defense of Georgia in Turkey.
2. The expenditures of the Ministry of Defense Personnel of Georgia to visit Turkey in order to increase the bilateral relations and participate in NATO PfP activities.
3. The expenditures related to other likely requirements.

**ARTICLE III  
IMPLEMENTATION PRINCIPLES**

The implementation principles of the financial assistance are stated as follows:

1. 142.500 (one hundred forty two thousand and five hundred) YTL equivalent to U.S. dollars is allocated to meet the expenses of the courses attended by the military personnel of Ministry of Defense of Georgia in Center of Excellence-Defense Against Terrorism and Partnership for Peace Training Center in the Republic of Turkey and the implementation essentials of this amount are as follows:

- a. The allocated source will be used for the purpose of meeting the expenses of the military personnel of Ministry of Defense of the Republic plane tickets, food, lodging, course fee and other requirements.

b. The planning regarding the personnel selection for the course will be conducted annually according to the present procedures.

2. 42.750 (fourty two thousand and seven hundred fifty) YTL equivalent to U.S. dollars is allocated to meet the expenses of the visit to Republic of Turkey and participation in NATO PfP activities of the Ministry of Defense of Georgia and their military personnel to Turkey in order to increase the bilateral relations between Parties.

3. 42.750 (fourty two thousand and seven hundred fifty) YTL equivalent to U.S. dollars is allocated to meet other requirements that may come about during the period of this Protocol.

4. The financial source shall be transferred by the Republic of Turkey to the bank account that will be determined by the Military Attache in Tbilisi. This source will be implemented under the control of the Tbilisi Military Attache with respect to directives given by the General Staff of the Republic of Turkey.

5. When necessary, the transfer between the sources will be conducted by General Staff of the Republic of Turkey.

#### **ARTICLE IV AMENDMENT AND SUPPLEMENT**

By mutual consent of the Parties, amendment and addition may be introduced into this protocol, which shall be reflected in separate protocols being integral parts of this implementing protocol and entering into force according to the provision of Article VI of this implementing protocol.

Any disputes arising during the implementation of this implementing protocol shall be solved through negotiations.

#### **ARTICLE V DURATION**

This Protocol shall be valid until using financial assistance source, after the General Staff of Republic of Turkey notifies the Ministry of Defense of Georgia that the transfer of the financial source is concluded.

#### **ARTICLE VI ENTRY INTO FORCE**

This Protocol enter into effect on the date of receipt of the last notification of completion of internal procedures required for its entry into effect by each Party.

DONE in Ankara/Turkey on November 26, 2008 in two original copies, each in Georgian, Turkish and English languages, all text are equally authentic. In case of divergence in interpretation, the English text shall prevail.
